



Stoneleigh Rally Challenge Awards

Challenge One - Train at Home

Navigate from top to bottom for a Purple Award, then take a new path from top to bottom, in addition to one across the board for a Green Award and then finally complete the board for a Rainbow Award.

1 From STAND Step away 1 pace & return	2 SIT to DOWN at heel	3 From STAND forward (min 1 pace)	4 PICKUP placed article (no present)	5 From SIT Step away 1 pace & return	6 SIT to STAND at heel	7 Stop in STAND (min 1 pace)
8 “TWIST” dog right	9 BACKUP 1 pace in front	10 Stop in SIT (min 1 pace)	11 From SIT to DOWN (Hinge down)	12 CALL to heel SIT	13 From DOWN to STAND (Cantilever)	14 CALL to front SIT
15 PICKUP thrown article (no present)	16 From STAND sidestep right STAND	17 SIT remove lead, stand upright, reattach lead	18 From STAND 90 left on the spot STAND	19 Catch treat OR food circuit	20 From STAND 360 left on the spot STAND	21 Take and HOLD article 3 secs RELEASE
22 From STAND 90 right on the spot STAND	23 From STAND to DOWN (Cantilever)	24 From STAND 360 right on the spot STAND	25 From DOWN to SIT (Hinge up)	26 From STAND send-around STAND	27 BACKUP 1 pace at heel	28 From STAND to SIT
29 From DOWN forward (min 1 pace)	30 From SIT to STAND (Kickback)	31 From DOWN Step away 1 pace & return	32 GIVE article to hand (informal)	33 From SIT forward (min 1 pace)	34 Stop in DOWN (min 1 pace)	35 “TWIST” dog left

Stoneleigh Rally Challenge Awards

Successful submissions will receive an Award Certificate and Ribbon

Purple Award £12

The aim is to get from top to bottom – you may move diagonally corner to corner.
You will need 5 connecting squares, 1 from each row.
All your squares may be filmed in the same place.

Green Award £18

For this award you need to take a new route from top to bottom as well as one from side to side – you may still move diagonally.
You will need an additional 10 squares to achieve this. Only 1 square can be repeated from the Purple Award and you may need to repeat a further square as your two lines intersect.

You must film at least one square in a new location (i.e. the kitchen instead of the living room).

Rainbow Award £18

Complete the board (so a further 20 squares).

You must film at least one of your additional squares in a new location making at least 3 different locations in total.

These challenges have been designed to be living room friendly so all the squares can be completed inside, although if the weather and restrictions in your area allow you are welcome to film outside. More details on the individual squares can be found in the dedicated Facebook group.

To claim your Challenge Award please submit videos of your chosen squares through the claim form on the website or in the dedicated Facebook group. Videos can be edited together but must clearly state which square is being claimed. Each Challenge Award submission must be accompanied by the submission fee.

The assessors' decisions are final.

All training should be a positive experience for both dog and handler, luring or handling your dog into position will result in that square needing to be resubmitted. You may have treats and/or toys on your person but these should not be used as a lure. You are encouraged to reward at the end of each square. All submitted squares must pass before your Award is confirmed. If only one square needs to be resubmitted this will be reassessed free of charge, however, if two or more of your squares are not passed at your first submission then there will be a reassessment fee of £5. Harsh handling will not be tolerated and will require full resubmission with no refund.
